



Adult Education Center/KET Partnership Information for the Student

Your local Adult Education Center and KET (Kentucky Educational Television) have partnered to provide study options for Kentuckians working on their GED. You may continue attending the Adult Education Center while also studying at home with materials from KET. Taking advantage of both services may help you earn your GED more quickly.

Here's how it works:

1. The GED exam costs \$40 to take.
2. For \$40 paid to KET now, KET is offering to send you a set of KET GED Connection workbooks (a \$20 value) AND pay your GED \$40 fee when it is determined you are ready for the test.
3. You can use the workbooks at your Adult Education Center and take them home for extra study.
4. You can write in the workbooks if you want because they are yours to keep.
5. You would complete each workbook lesson after you watch a GED Connection program (either by DVD at the Adult Education Center or at home with KET broadcasts). There are 39 30-minute programs covering all five GED subjects.
6. Your Adult Education instructor will go over your workbook lessons and help you with all your study questions and needs.
7. You will take progress assessments and the Official GED Practice Test as determined by the Adult Education Center.

What do you have to do to participate? Fill out a registration form (at your Adult Education Center) and pay the \$40 to KET by personal check or money order. A set of GED Connection workbooks will be mailed to your home address and a \$40 GED Test Voucher will be sent to the Adult Education Center to put in your student folder. You will use the GED voucher when certified as ready to take the GED exam.

The benefit is that you can study more and do extra work at home watching the KET GED Connection programs and using the workbooks. The Adult Education Center will still provide all the same instruction and services you need and want. You will still take your Official GED Practice Test at the center to determine when you are ready to take the GED.
